

PRESCRIBED MUSIC FOR SOLOS AND ENSEMBLES

A. Woodwind, Brass and String Solos (may be played with or without accompaniment)

1. Solos may be taken from the Wisconsin School Music Association (WSMA) list which can be found at http://wsmamusic.org/music_list/index.html.
2. Solos found in the Standard of Excellence Method Books (or any other band or string method books) may also be played.
3. Beginners are encouraged to play a selection from WSMA Class C list, but may play any piece of 20 or more measures.
4. Other suggested books include: Solo Time for Band, Solo Sounds, Belwin Master Solos and Tunes for Technic.

B. Ensembles (may be played with or without accompaniment)

1. Ensembles may be taken from the WSMA list which can be found at http://wsmamusic.org/music_list/index.html.
2. Ensembles may be taken from any other books with the proper instrumentation.
3. Other suggested books include: Duet Adventures and Yamaha Band Ensembles.

C. Percussion

1. Any solos (for either mallets or snare drum) may be taken from the WSMA list which can be found at http://wsmamusic.org/music_list/index.html.
2. Solos found in the Standard of Excellence Method Books (or any other band method books) may also be played.
3. Other suggested books include: Contest Solos for the Young Snare Drummer, More Contest Solos for the Young Snare Drummer, and Alfred Drum Method Books 1 and 2.
